FROM THE PASTORS' DESK



THERE IS NO OVERNIGHT SUCCESS! Ezekiel 17:23, Acts 1:4-8

In the age of social media, YouTube sensations and viral blogs, it seems like we are witnessing "overnight success" stories of mega churches, businesses, musicians and Hollywood stars. But is there such a thing as "overnight success?" Most entrepreneurs will tell you loudly "NO".

A normal tree has to grow in two directions at the same time. A bamboo tree has to grow for four to five years in one of the two directions a normal tree takes to grow.

A normal tree grows downward and grows upward at the same time. A bamboo tree grows down for four years. When the seed is planted, it endures the darkness on the ground, the dampness, and the hard resistance. The root system has resistance, it has to push through the hard ground and rocks in order to go down further. But once it breaks the earth, it goes up and there is no more resistance against its' roots. The root is that part of the bamboo tree that grows down away from light and away from gravity. During the first four years of its development, it rarely grows at all, staying underground and seemly doing nothing. It is only in the fifth year that the bamboo tree suddenly shoots up, growing as high as 80 feet in just six weeks. This demonstrates a remarkable exercise of patience, perseverance and trust.

The farmer faithfully watered, fed, and cared for the soil, in which he planted the bamboo seeds, for a period of four years though he saw no sign of life. No growth, no sprout and no hope. And we are wondering O Lord, how long?

How could something that I have so diligently cared for and reap absolutely no reward. Just as he was about to give up on his dream of growing the plant, he noticed it started to sprout and sprung up 80 feet over the next six weeks.

How did it happen? Did the bamboo lie dormant and then suddenly shoot up 80 feet in six weeks, of course not. What the farmer and the on lookers couldn't see during those four fruitless years was the root systems the plant was developing to support its rapid ascent above ground. If the bamboo tree had not developed a strong root system, it wouldn't have been able to support such massive and quick growth. What's more, if you ever tried to control or get rid of the bamboo tree, you know it's nearly impossible.

Patience is a virtue that the bible has encouraged us to cultivate. It is the ability to wait calmly and patiently without complaint in the face of frustration or delay. This is a valuable trait to have in all aspect of life as servants of God.

Habakkuk 2:1 begins with Habakkuk asking God, "O Lord, how long shall I cry, and you will not hear? Even cry out to you, violence! And you will not save."

This story demonstrates that patience, faith and perseverance pay off over time and what appears to be "overnight success" is usually the product of years of hard work.

Like the farmer, we may not immediately see the fruits of our labour in our journey towards success, but here are three things we can learn from the story.

- Authentic relationships are a key to success: relationships are your root system. Genuine relationships take years to build and often do not provide an immediate and visible payoff. However, strong relationships give you a strong foundation for success. So, God wants us to build a strong relationship with Him. In John 15:5-7 Jesus asked us to abide in Him, in order to bear fruits.
- Patience is a virtue: the culture of impatience and instant gratification in which we currently live, has us very accustomed to getting immediate results. Our cultures highly valued speed and convenience. However, when it comes to walking with God, this is not always the best philosophy. Jesus said in Matthew 13:5-6 that some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediate sprang up because they had no depth of earth. But when the sun was up, they were scorched, and because they had no roots, they withered quickly. Remember, the best things in life are best waiting for.
- You got to have faith: have faith in God, in yourself and your God given vision. Had the farmer become discouraged and given up after two or three years, he wouldn't have experienced his dream becoming a reality. The book of James 2:17 says faith without works is dead. Hebrews 11:6 says, but without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that a rewarder of those who diligently seek him. Have faith in that what you are growing in God's name. We might make mistakes, get frustrated, feel discouraged and want to quit along the way. We must remember what's driving us in the first place. Believing in oneself helps others believe in you too.

The bamboo tree teaches us that though success may appear to happen overnight, it's really the result of hard work, perseverance, and faith building what most people can't see. Let everyone laugh while we continue to build our relationship with God, that will form the root system of our future success.


