
Let us not think that ... "because it hasn't happened yet, it will never happen" or believe that "because it has always happened, it has to continue to happen".

To begin, an Award sometimes is called a Distinction, something given to a recipient as a token of <u>recognition of excellence in certain field</u>. The purpose of an awards ceremony makes people feel that their work is valued. That is, it shows approval and gratitude for each person's job, and it makes people aware that good work will always be rewarded.

On Friday, 10th June 2022, our Founder and Senior Pastor, Pa Sheriff Jalloh was recognisied as the Queensland Community Foundation's 2022 Emerging Philanthropist of the Year.

The QCF Emerging Philanthropist of the Year Award honours an innovative, emerging philanthropist, whose significant early achievements embody the qualities that define philanthropic excellence, including outstanding generosity and creativity. This Award is not about the biggest cheque, or the largest public profile. The successful nominee and recipient is someone who has demonstrated creativity in philanthropic efforts through leadership, voluntary commitment of time, advocacy, financial donations and fundraising. They will be an inspirational role model, whose charitable impact is measurable.




Coming down to Preaching, there were 2 speakers that ministered the Word of God.





A child's Dedication is an act of consecration of Children to God in Churches, such as The House of Prayer. The Biblical purpose and history of Baby Dedication: The scriptural root of a baby dedication is found in **1 Samuel 1:27-28 (NASB)**, where a Godly woman named Hannah prayed year after year for God to give her a child. "For this boy I prayed, and the Lord has given me my petition which I asked of Him. So I have also dedicated him to the Lord; as long as he lives he is dedicated to the Lord." - 1Samuel 1:27-28

- 2. Bro Bill Roberts & Sis. Dorcas Dongbo, and their child name Nadia Roberts.



decreases in our Giving.


